And now at this term of the Court on examining the above account of Thomas Crocker under keeper of the State's jail in Paris in said County of Oxford, on oath exhibited, do find that the charges for the support of Prisoners in said jail, unable to support themselves, committed upon due process of law, upon charge or conviction of crimes against the State & therein confined from the 9th day of October 1827 amount to the sum of thirteen dollars & forty five cents, and that said prisoners have not been able to pay any part thereof, therefore said sum has been allowed & ordered by the Court to be paid out of the Treasury of this County & charged to the State agreeably to the Statute in such case made & provided.
