This document lay out on the
first in Jason Clark

Sheriff of Court of County Commissioners
March Term 1833, The Court on examining the
account of Jason Clark Keeper of the State Jail in
Knox County in the County of Somerset on oath
exhibited, do find that the charges for the support of
prisoners in said jail unable to support themselves
committed by due process of law upon charge or
conviction of crimes against the State and therein
confined from the fifth day of October 1832 to the
twentieth day of March 1833 amounts to seventy one
Dollars and thirty six cents and that said prisoners have
not been able to pay any part thereof. Therefore
said sum has been allowed and ordered by the
Court to be paid out of the Treasury of this County
and charged to the State agreeably to the Statute
in such case made and provided
