The undersigned commissioners under the act of separation having adjusted the Accounts of Joseph C Norris for surveys made by our order and sundry disbursements, & found a balance due him of Seven hundred forty eight dollars & seventy eight Cents, and ordered that the sum of Five hundred dollars be now paid him in part, out of the contingent fund placed at the disposal of this Board hereby request the Executives of the two States, to draw their Warrants in favor of said Joseph C Norris, each for one moiety of said last mentioned sum, to wit the sum of two hundred & fifty dollars.
