January Term 1833 -

And now the Court on examination of the within account, find the charges for support of prisoners in Gaol, unable to support themselves, confined by due process of law, on charge or conviction of crimes or offences against the State, from the fourth day of September 1832 to January 7<sup>th</sup> 1833 following, inclusive, amount to the sum of sixty eight dollars & ninety six cents, & that said prisoners have not been able to pay any part thereof -

Whereupon, it is ordered that the same be allowed & paid out of the County Treasury & charged to the State, agreeable to the statute in such case provided -
