The Court on examining the within account of Jonas Parlin J. late keeper of the State's Gaol in Norridgewick, in the County of Somerset, on oath exhibited do find the charges for the support of prisoners in said Gaol unable to support themselves, committed upon due process of law, upon charges and convictions of crimes against the State, from the eighteenth day of March 1830 to the fifth day of April 1830, inclusive, amounting to the sum of three dollars and twelve cents, to be regular and correct, and that said prisoners have not been able to pay any part thereof, the same is therefore allowed and ordered to be paid out of the Treasury of said County and charged to the State,
