Gen. Ladd -

Mem^o. of agreement this day made between Daniel
Woodbury & Charles Milliken on the one part, and Saml. G. Ladd Adjutant
Genl. of the State of Maine on the other part - to wit -

The said Woodbury & Milliken agree to remove all
the ordnance, shot & other military articles and
property belonging to the State of Maine now lying
at Fish or Fishers Point & Mount Fry in Portland
to the Arsenal belonging to the said State in Portland
aforesaid, & to deliver & place the same at such places
within the yard of the Arsenal aforesaid, as the said Ladd
shall direct by the 25th day of August instant, to be
delivered in good order, and free from all damage - and
the said Woodbury & Milliken to receive as a full
compensation for the above service thirty three cents per
Ton of 2240^{lbs} and the said Ladd agrees to pay
the same when the said property is all removed as
above stated by the said - Woodbury & Milliken


