At a meeting of the County Commissioners begun & holden at Paris in & for the County of Oxford on the last Tuesday of October A.D. 1832.

And now at this Term, on examining the foregoing account of Thomas Crocker Keeper of the State Jail in Paris in the County of Oxford, on oath exhibited, the County Commissioners do find, that the charges for support of Prisoners in said Jail made to support themselves, committed upon due process of law, upon charge or conviction of crimes against the State, & therein confined from the fourth Tuesday of October 1831, amount to the sum of Seventeen Dollars & fifty seven cents, & that said Prisoners have not been able to pay any part thereof - therefore said sum has been allowed & ordered to be paid out of the Treasury of this County & charged to the State agreeably to the statute in such case made & provided.
