on oath exhibited, find that the charges made for the support of
Prisoners, committed on legal process of Law, upon charges or con-
viction of crimes against the State, and confined from the 18th
Dec^r A.D. 1832 to June 4th 1833. amounts to the sum of three hun-
dred thirty seven dollars 14/100. and that said prisoners have not
been able to pay any part thereof: - Therefore Ordered that said
sum be paid out of the County Treasury of said County, and charges
to the State
