The undersigned commissioners under the act of
separation, having adjusted the accounts of Andrew McMillan for surveys
made by our order and sundry disbursements, & found a balance due him
of five hundred forty dollars & forty seven cents and ~~advised~~ having
heretofore drawn for a part of said sum to wit for three hundred dollars,
and now having ordered payment of the balance due him viz
two hundred forty dollars & forty seven cents, hereby request the Executives
of the two States to draw their warrants in favor of said Andrew McMillan
each for one moiety of said last mentioned sum to wit for the sum of
one hundred twenty dollars & twenty three & an half cents.
