To the Sheriff of the County of New-York -

Whereas it has been represented to me, that William Livermore late of Portland in the State of Maine now confined in the jail of your county, charged with obtaining goods under false pretences in the State of Maine and having fled from that State to avoid the punishment of his - crime; and it is sufficiently proved to me that he is guilty thereof; and the Governor of the State of Maine having demanded of me that the said William Livermore

should be delivered to Jeremiah Martin

to be brought back within the jurisdiction of said State:

I do therefore, by virtue of the power vested in me by the Constitution and Laws of the United States, order you to deliver the said William Livermore

into the custody of the said Jeremiah

Martin
for the purposes aforesaid.

Given under my Hand, and the Privy Seal of the State, at the City of Albany, this Twenty-fifth day of June - in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and thirty- Six
