And now the Court, on Examination find, that the charges made in the within account, for support of prisoners in goal unable to support themselves, confined by due process of Law on charge or conviction of crimes or offences against the state from the 13th day of May to the 8th day of September 1829, inclusive amount to the sum of Thirty eight Dollars forty two cents, & that said prisoners have not been able to pay any part thereof whereupon, It is Ordered, that the same be allowed & paid out of the County Treasury & charged to the State agreeable to the Statute in such case provided.
