In Council Oct. 27. 1829

The standing Committee on Warrants Report:

That there is now due to the legal Representative of Enoch Lincoln, late Governor ^{of this State,} deceased, the sum of thirty two dollars and eighty ^{eight} cents, being the amount of his Salary from the thirtieth day of September last to the eighth day of October current inclusive (being the time of his decease)

The Committee therefore recommend that the officiating Governor be advised to draw his warrant on the Treasury of this State in favor of the legal Representative of the said Enoch Lincoln, deceased, for the said sum thirty two dollars and eighty eight cents, which will be in full for his Salary during the time aforesaid.
