The Standing Committee on County Treasurer's Accounts to which was referred the Account of Daniel Pike Treasurer of the County of Kennebec having carefully examined the same. Report: That they find the same well vouched and correctly cast; they have however deducted the sum of eighteen dollars and twenty nine cents for the Board of ~~the~~ Jose Holley confined as a Lunatic as they are of the opinion that the expense incident to the imprisonment of said Holley should be paid by the town in which said Holley was found and not by the State, there is therefore a balance due from the State to said Treasurer after deducting the expenses of said Holley of ~~one thousand~~ Five Hundred Eighty two dollars and Forty Six Cents. The Committee therefore recommend that the Governor be advised to draw his Warrant on the Treasurer of State in favor of Daniel Pike Treasurer as aforesaid the sum of Five Hundred Eighty two dollars and Forty Six Cents. which will be in full for the balance of his account to the nineteenth of June 1839.
