Penobscot J. Court of County Commissioners December Term 1833.

And now the Court on examination of said accounts do find the charges for support of prisoners in said Gaol, unable to support themselves, confined by due process of law on charge or conviction of crimes or offences against the State, from the seventh day of August 1833, to the tenth day of December 1833, inclusive, amount to the sum of sixty one dollars and thirty four cents, and that said Prisoners have not been able to pay any part thereof. Whereupon, it is ordered, that the same be allowed and paid out of the County Treasury, and charged to the State, agreeably to the Statute in such case, provided,
