A statement, on oath, exhibited by Levi Bradley, undersheriff of the jail in Bangor in the County of Penobscot, for the support of persons therein confined, on charge or conviction of crimes, and offences against the State, and which by law is chargeable to the State from December 10<sup>th</sup> 1834, to April 7<sup>th</sup> 1835, inclusive.

And now the Court on examination of said account do find the charges for support of prisoners in said jail, unable to support themselves, confined by due process of law on charge or conviction of crimes or offences against the State, from the 10<sup>th</sup> day of December, A. D. 1834, to the 7<sup>th</sup> day of April, A. D. 1835 inclusive, amount to the sum of one hundred and two dollars, and fifty eight cents, and that said prisoners have not been able to pay any part thereof. Whereupon it is ordered, that the same be allowed and paid out of the County Treasury, and charged to the State, agreeably to the Statute in such case provided.
