At a meeting of the County Commissioners begun & holden at Topsham, within & for the County of Lincoln on the sixth day of October A.D. 1835, by adjournment from the first Monday of September, being the 7th day of said month, A.D. 1835.

The Court on examination of the within account do find the charges for support of Prisoners in Gaol, unable to support themselves, confined by due process of Law on charge or conviction of crimes or offences against the State from the twelfth day of May, 1835 to the fifth day of October following, both inclusive, amount to the sum of fifty one Dollars, eighty five cents. and that said Prisoners have not been able to pay any part thereof. Whereupon it is Ordered, that the same be allowed & paid out of the County Treasury & charged to the State, agreeable to the Statute in such case provided.
