An account exhibited by Sewall Crockett Keeper of the State's Jail in Paris in the County of Oxford for the support of Prisoners therein confined upon charge or conviction of crimes or offences against the State from the 17th day of June 1835 to the 28th day of October 1835.

County Commissioners Court, October Term, 1835.

And now in this Term, the Court, on examining the foregoing account of Sewall Crockett Keeper of the Jail aforesaid, on oath exhibited, do find that the charges for the support of Prisoners in Jail unable to support themselves, committed by due process of law upon charge or conviction of crimes against the State & therein confined from the 17th day of June 1835 to the 28th day of October 1835 amount to twelve dollars + 86/100 and that said prisoners have been unable to pay any part thereof: therefore said sum has been allowed & ordered by the Court to be paid out of the Treasury of this County & charged to the State agreeably to the Statute in such case made & provided.
