Hartford May 24 1836


Sir  
Inclosed I send you the account of The American Asylum with The State of Maine for the last year; balance due the Asylum, six hundred & sixty one <sup>19</sup>/<sub>100</sub> dollars. There are now in the Asylum on account of The State of Maine nine pupils; but as I understand ~~that~~ several more are soon expected, I will, at some future time, forward you an estimate of charges for the present half year.
