Somerset Co. Court of County Commissioners at Norridgewock
March Term A. D. 1836.

The Court on examining the within account of Joseph H. Hill, Keeper of the States Gaol in Norridgewock, in said County on oath exhibited, do find that the charges for the support of Prisoners therein confined on due process of law upon charges or conviction of crimes or offences against the State from the Eighth day of October 1835 to the Seventeenth day of March 1836 amounts to the sum of Sixty four Dollars and Eighty two cents, which appears to be now due and unpaid. It is therefore Ordered, that the said sum of Sixty four Dollars and Eighty two cents be allowed to the said Joseph H. Hill, and that the same be paid out of the Treasury of this County and charged to the State agreeably to the provisions of the Law.
