At a Court of the County Commissioners for the County of Washington, begun and holden at Machias within lands for said County on the first Wednesday next after the first Tuesday of March A.D. 1835 being the fourth day of said month.

"David G. Wilson Keeper of the States Jail in this County exhibit his  
" accounts against the State for boarding prisoners up to the tenth  
" day of March 1835 amounting to sixty five dollars and sixty nine  
" cents (65.69) and makes oath to the same as the law directs."

At the same Court held at Machias aforesaid and continued by adjournment to Wednesday the first day of July A.D. 1835. the following record appears. to wit.

" David G. Wilson Keeper of the States Jail in this County exhibit  
" his account against the State for boarding prisoners up to the  
" second day of July 1835 amounting to Forty nine dollars and  
" ninety seven cents (49.97) and makes oath to the same  
" as the law directs"

And at the same Court held at Machias aforesaid on the first Wednesday next after the third Tuesday of September A.D. 1835 being the sixteenth day of said month. The following record is made. to wit. "David G. Wilson Keeper of the States Jail  
" in this County exhibit his account against the State for boarding  
" prisoners up to the twentieth day of Sept. A.D. 1835 amounting to  
" thirty seven dollars & twenty five cents (37.25) and makes oath  
" to the same as the law directs"
