Washington Co., Court of County Commissioners, December adjourned Term 1836.

The Court on examining the above account of Benjamin L. Pomroy Keeper of the State Gaol in Machias in said County; on oath exhibited, do find that the charges of supporting prisoners in said Gaol unable to support themselves, committed by due process of law upon charges or convictions of Crimes against the State, and therein confined from the 20th day of October to the 20th day of December 1836 amount to the sum of Twenty Six Dollars and thirty four cents, that said prisoners have not been able to pay any part thereof, that said sum has been allowed and paid out of the County Treasury of said County, and is by law to be charged to the State.
