Washington Co. Court of County Commissioners March 7. 1837. The Court on examining the above account exhibited on oath by Benjamin L Pomroy Keeper of the States Gaol in Machias in said County. do find that the charges of supporting Prisoners in said Gaol, unable to support themselves, committed by due process of law upon charge or conviction of Crimes against the State and therein confined from the twentieth day of December A.D. 1836. to the seventh day of March ^{AD 1837} inclusive. amount to the sum of Eighty Dollars and twenty six cents, that said Prisoners have not been able to pay said sum or any part thereof. that said sum has been allowed and paid out of the County Treasury of said County. and is by law to be charged to the State.
