Somerset, Court of County Commissioners at Nonidgewock March Term A.D. 1838. The County Commissioners having examined the within account of Joseph H. Hill Keeper of the State Gaol in Nonidgewock in said County of Somerset (on oath exhibited) do find the charges for the support of prisoners therein confined on due process of Law, upon charges or convictions of crimes or offences against the State from Oct. 5. 1837 to March 21. 1838 amount to the sum of Eighty Dollars & fifty five cents, which appears to be now due and unpaid. It is therefore Ordered, that the same be allowed and paid to the said Joseph H. Hill out of the Treasury of this County and charged to the State agreeably to the provisions of the law.
