The Court on examining the within account of Joseph H. Hill Keeper of the States Jail in Norridgewock, on oath, exhibited, do find that the charges for the support of prisoners therein confined, unable to support them selves, committed on due process of law, upon charges or conviction of crimes or offences against the state, from Oct T. 1836 to March term 1837 amount to seventeen dollars and seventy one cent, and that the said prisoners have been unable to pay any part thereof; The Court therefore order that the aforesaid sum be paid out of the Treasury of this County and charged to the State agreeably to the provisions of the law.
