Estimated bills unpaid for repairs of Church 50.00

" Expense of clothing children for school 100.00

" Books & School apparatus 25.00

" Purchasing lots to the Indians 100.00

" To furnish children sup. for school 100.00

" For ploughing this fall 37.55

\$ 1100.00

Please draw in my favor for the amount or  
what you shall deem proper

I have estimated for what I think necessary  
for the proper management of the Indians this fall

On the 9 Sept I wrote you, & in this time changed  
some of my estimates & a part of the bills then outstanding  
I have paid.
