The Committee on Public Buildings, to which was referred the account of Herman Turner Superintendent of the Public Buildings, having had the same under consideration as it came to report - That the sum is correctly cast & properly balanced - that the amount of six hundred dollars for furniture & repairs & improvement of the grounds amount to six hundred eighty five dollars & five cents & for light & fuel four hundred & ninety nine dollars & thirty nine cents - making the whole amount claim three hundred & forty eight dollars & forty four cents -

He has credited the State with warrants 4206 & 4436 for five hundred dollars each which were drawn upon the administration for furniture & repairs - also with warrant 4452 for twenty five dollars drawn on the Contingent fund & by six dollars & forty three cents according from the sale of 2^d hand imports - making the whole amount of his credit claim three hundred forty one dollars & forty three cents & leaving a general balance of thirty four dollars & one cent due Mr Farmer - The committee

consider was much as warrant 4206 & 4476
amounting to \$1000 were drawn upon a specific
appropriation it is proper that the sum be turned

the sum which is now needed in his hands a-
