He has credited the State with warrants 44206 & 4436 for five hundred dollars each which were drawn upon the appropriation for furniture & repairs - also with warrant 4452 for twenty five dollars drawn on the Contingent fund & Sixty six dollars & forty three cents accruing from the sale of 2^d hand carpets - making the whole amount of his credits shown Hundred forty one dollars & forty three cents & leaving a general balance of thirty four dollars & one cent due Mr. Turner - The committee

consider was much as warrants to 206 + 4486
amounting to 1000 were drawn upon a specific
appropriation it is proper that the balance of
the same which is now held in his hands a-
mounting to three hundred fourteen dollars +
ninety five cents + recommend that he be
directed to refund the same to the Treasurer
which shall be carried to the account for the
appropriation for repairs + in order
to balance his account + recommend further
that the Governor be advised to draw his war-
rant upon the Treasurer of State for the sum
of three hundred fifty one dollars + ninety
five cents in favor of J. Turner + in full
of his account to be paid out of a charge
to the contingent fund -
