Washington Co. Court of County Commissioners March Term A.D. 1837. The Court on examining the above account of William Brown keeper of the States Jail in Machias in said County, on oath exhibited, do find that the charges of supporting Prisoners in said Jail unable to support themselves, committed by due process of law, upon charge or conviction of Crimes against the State, and therein confined from the 24<sup>th</sup> day of September to the 21<sup>st</sup> day of October 1836 inclusive, amount to the sum of Eight Dollars and fifty eight cents, that said Prisoners have not been able to pay any part thereof, that said sum has been allowed and paid out of the County Treasury of said County, and is by law to be charged to the State.
