And now the Court on examination of said account do find the charges for support of Prisoners in said Gaol, unable to support themselves, confined by due process of Law, on charge or conviction of crimes or offences against the State from the sixth day of August to the eleventh day of December 1838 inclusive, amount to the sum of One hundred thirty one dollars and twelve cents, and that said Prisoners have not been able to pay any part thereof. Whereupon it is Ordered, that the same be allowed and paid out of the County Treasury and charged to the State, agreeably to the Statute in such case provided.
