County Commissioners Court, June Term A. D. 1834.

And now at this Term, the Court, on examining the above account of Thomas Crocker, under keeper of the State Jail in Paris in the County of Oxford, on oath exhibited, do find that the charges for support of Prisoners in said Jail, unable to support themselves, committed by due process of law upon charge or conviction of crimes against the State & therein confined from the 29th day of October 1833 amount to the sum of ten dollars & twenty eight cents & that said Prisoners have been unable to pay any part thereof, therefore said sum has been allowed & ordered by the Court to be paid out of the Treasury of this County & charged to the State agreeably to the Statute in such case made & provided.
