To His Excellency the Governor of the State
of Maine & His Honourable Council

The undersigned Inhabitants of China & the
adjoining towns in the County of Kennebec
would represent, that they are desirous of
being formed into an independent company of
Militia, Light Infantry and that by the organiza-
-tion of such company of Light Infantry, no
standing company to which we severally belong
would be reduced below the number of forty effective
privates, exclusive of those between the ages of thirty-
five and forty five years - We therefore request
that we may be forthwith organized into such
company of Light Infantry accordingly
Sept. 19th 1836
