# STATE OF MAINE.

IN COUNCIL, *March 27<sup>th</sup> 1838.*

The Standing Committee on the Pay Roll of the Council, Report: That the whole amount of Pay for travel and attendance of the *First* Session of the *Eighteenth* Council, which commenced on the *twenty fourth* day of *January* and ended on the *twenty eighth* day of *March 1838*, is *one thousand and twenty five* Dollars, and that the pay of the Messenger during the same time, is *\$124* Dollars, amounting in the whole to *Eleven hundred and forty nine* Dollars. The Committee recommend therefore that the Governor be advised to draw his Warrant on the Treasurer of State in favor of the persons therein named, and for the several sums therein specified. To be charged to and paid out of the appropriation made for the payment thereof under the Act of *March tenth* A. D. 1838.
