# STATE OF MAINE.

IN COUNCIL,

Feb'y. 11 1836.

The Standing Committee on WARRANTS, Report:

That by a Resolve, entitled "Resolve in Favor of Thurston Card," passed January 20. 1827- there is directed to be paid out of the Treasury of State, to the said Thurston Card, the sum of forty eight dollars, in equal semi-annual payments, during the pleasure of the Legislature, to commence on the 1st day of February 1827- they therefore recommend that the Governor be advised to draw his warrant on the Treasurer of State, in favor of Thurston Card, for the sum of twenty four dollars, which will be in full for his pension up to the thirty first day of July 1835. inclusive - to be charged agreeably to the appropriation made for the payment thereof, under the Act of March 25. 1835 -
