August 17, 1952 The first Old Home Sunday in many years was held. It was a huge success. See the program and news paper report which are on file. A message from Mr. J. Henry Dow the oldest Sunday School member of this church was read and his offering placed on the plate by the youngest Sunday School member. Greetings were read from Executive Secretary Elmer N. Bentley and Vermont Executive Secretary Rev. Homer C. Bryant.

October 27, 1952 A meeting of the church was held at the home of Mrs. Stillman Brewer at 8 P. M. Opened with prayer by Mr. Maser. Treasurer's report was read. She paid for paint and painters 326.38. 10 gallons of paint on hand which cost 41.50. Voted to sell 5 gallons of this paint to Sidney Webster for what it cost the church. The bill of Arthur Boye for ~~the~~ \$394⁰⁰ was discussed. It was voted to pay him 1/2 of his bill now \$197⁰⁰. It was voted to instruct the clerk to write a letter to the executive secretary Rev. Elmer Bentley, asking for aid on the paint bill explaining that the job had cost \$720.38. We have paid \$523.38 leaving a balance due of \$197⁰⁰. Voted to drop the aid we have been receiving from the Convention, if we receive help on the paint bill, and to continue the payment of \$9⁵⁰ per week to the pastor ourselves. Benevolent report for last 3 months was read. United Budget 5.26, World Fellowship \$1.35 making a total of \$6.61. Quarterly report to Convention read and approved.

"But when said church shall fail to maintain such preaching the income of the sum aforesaid shall be appropriated to the general work of the Me. Baptist Missionary Convention for the time being."
