To the Governor and Members of the Executive Council:

Corrected Tabulation of the
Vote for Representative to the
Legislature at the General Elec-
tion held on November 3, 1964

As a result of a recount of the ballots cast at
the General Election on November 3, 1964, in the Towns of
Avon, Eustis, Kingfield, Madrid, Phillips, Rangeley,
Strong, and the Plantations of Coplin, Dallas, Rangeley
and Sandy River for the office of Representative to the
Legislature, I hereby submit a corrected tabulation for
Mr. Ernest D. Smith and Mr. George A. Palmer in accordance
with the facts as determined at such recount. A copy of
the signed agreement relating thereto is attached herewith
and made a part of the record.

Ernest D. Smith of Strong received 1,270
votes, instead of 1,284 votes, and

George A. Palmer of Phillips received
1,297 votes, instead of 1,278 votes.

Therefore, George A. Palmer of Phillips having re-
ceived a plurality of the votes cast in his respective dis-
trict appears to have been elected, instead of Ernest D.
Smith of Strong.
