INSTRUCTIONS TO MUNICIPAL CLERKS WHERE VOTERS OF UNINCORPORATED TOWNSHIPS ARE REGISTERED

FROM: ELECTION DIVISION -- SECRETARY OF STATE

The 104th Legislature in its passage of the Sunday Sale of Liquor referendum has stipulated that voters in unorganized townships be allowed to vote on the Sunday liquor question for their unorganized township.

If your municipality has such voters on your voting list, and such voters are inhabitants of an unincorporated place where there are more than 20 residents over 21 years of age according to tax lists of the Maine Bureau of Taxation, you must allow those registered voters an opportunity to cast a ballot on the Sunday Sale question whether or not liquor is sold the rest of the week.

Those municipalities which received a questionnaire from this office earlier are aware of the townships eligible to vote. For your convenience, they are listed below. Only registered voters from those places may vote on the liquor question.

5. Before counting Sunday Sale ballots, segregate and count separately the ballots from each unincorporated township.
6. Send results of Sunday Sale voting for such unorganized townships separately from but included with results from your own municipality.
