Hancock or either of his deputies, or the constable
of the town of Sebree within our said county, or any
or either of them. — Greeting

Whereas Ebenezer Chase of Sebree in our said county
of Hancock aforesaid, yeoman, on the twenty fourth day
of January in the year of our Lord eighteen hundred & ^{fourteen} ~~thirteen~~
before Moses Greenleaf Esquire, one of our Justices of the
peace for our county aforesaid recovered judgement against
Clement Bunker & Stephen Bunker of Sebree aforesaid
Yeomen, for the sum of three Dollars ninety two cents
debtor damage, & two Dollars forty cents for charges of
suit, as to us appears of record, whereof execution remains
to be done, we command you therefore that of the money
of the said Clement Bunker & Stephen Bunker, or of their
goods or chattels within your precinct, at the value thereof
in money, you cause to be levied paid & satisfied unto
the said Ebenezer Chase the aforesaid sum, being six
Dollars & thirty two cents in the whole, & also that
out of the money goods or chattels of the said Clement
Bunker & Stephen Bunker you levy twenty five
cents more for this writ together with your own
fees. — Hereof fail not & make return of this
writ with your doings therein unto our said Justice
within sixty days next coming —
