Dear Sir

I recd your order to look after Wm Austin a deserter supposed to be in Parkman,

Parkman is a secret hole and many of them would help secrete him I am known in Parkman as the man who is after desertus and as I had been over the town once my presence there again would put the copper heads in motion, I thought best not to go but went to Sangerville four miles from Parkman and employed Sheriff Jewett a bottom fool who is there often and would not be suspicious till he put his hand on him, and then if he did not get him the first day he being so handy could go again. It is twenty five miles from here, I told him to take or send him to Bangor jail and certify you, He said to Jewett

other I wrote you as being at home, furlough
out, was at Augusta when I called the
second time

Eleazer B. Tolman, who was said to have
started for Augusta sick, his father (Horn. P.
Tolman) says he has not returned but writes
that he got his discharge at Augusta

Edward Ricker Co D. 2 regt
No papers, gone from home when I called
first went to Augusta and to Annapolis

Saron Bragden Co A. 6 regt
was at Augusta (second call) I hear
from his father since that he has returned
with his discharge, no doubt of it as Doct
Cook said his knee was rotten with sores

Frank Severance Co - 6. regt
Enlisted in Bangor, now in Sebec furlough
out, will never be able to report in person
at Augusta, won't live long probably

James J. Ellis Co H 11 regt
(Second call) gone to Augusta to report
in person

Warright Cushing Co A. 6. regt
Furlough. left for Augusta before it was out
He writes from the Army since.
