that Isaac Gelpatrick of that Town  
Enlisted in Capt Seth Leonard's Company  
B, 15 Maine Regiment, and was sick  
at the time the Regiment Marched to the  
War, and that he is well at this  
time a stout strong man  
and kept out of sight for fear  
he might be taken and they want to have  
him go as he has lost the Government  
Some think all ready
