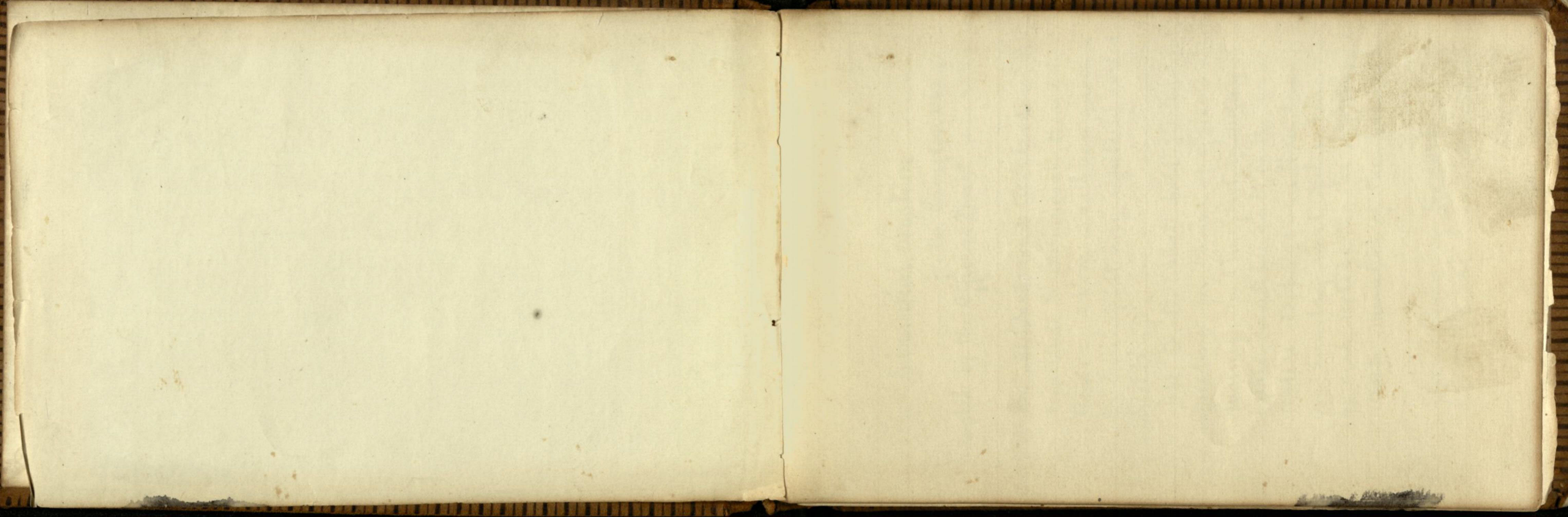

Financial System

For the Crington Charge
Adopted by the Official Board June 25th 1871

1st. The Stewards and Chapleaders shall constitute a Financial Board two thirds of whom shall be a quorum for business at any regularly called meeting.

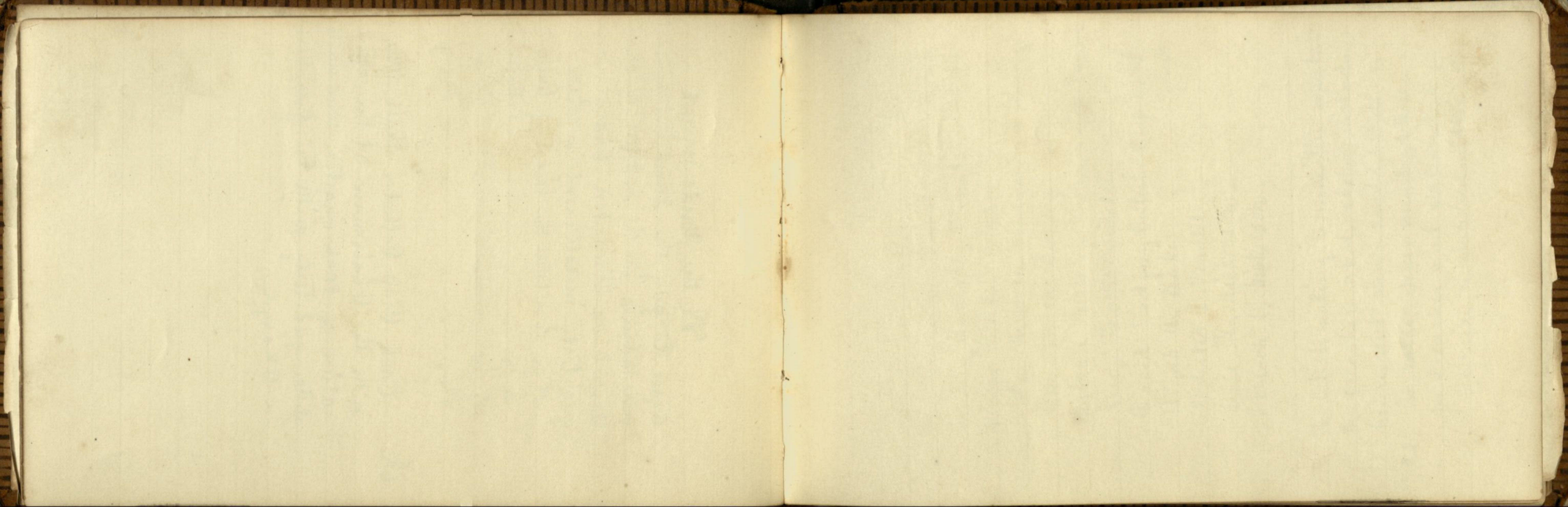
2^d. The F. B. shall hold its Annual meeting for choice of officers and business on the first Monday in June or at the call of the Secretary's notice to be given from the Desk on Sunday next preceeding and special notice by the Secretary to each member of the board,

3^d. The officers of the F. B. shall be a Chairman who shall

be receiving and disbursing agent of the funds of the Society, a Secretary and one Collector for each Class, who shall perform the duties of said offices respectively.

4th, The T. B. shall at its annual meeting raise a sum or sums of money sufficient to meet the claims of the preacher in Charge and defray all necessary expenses on the parsonage, its outbuildings and grounds, and shall apportion the same to the several Classes according to their ability.

5th, It shall be the duty of the Class Collector immediately on receiving his apportionment to circulate a subscription in his Class headed as follows.

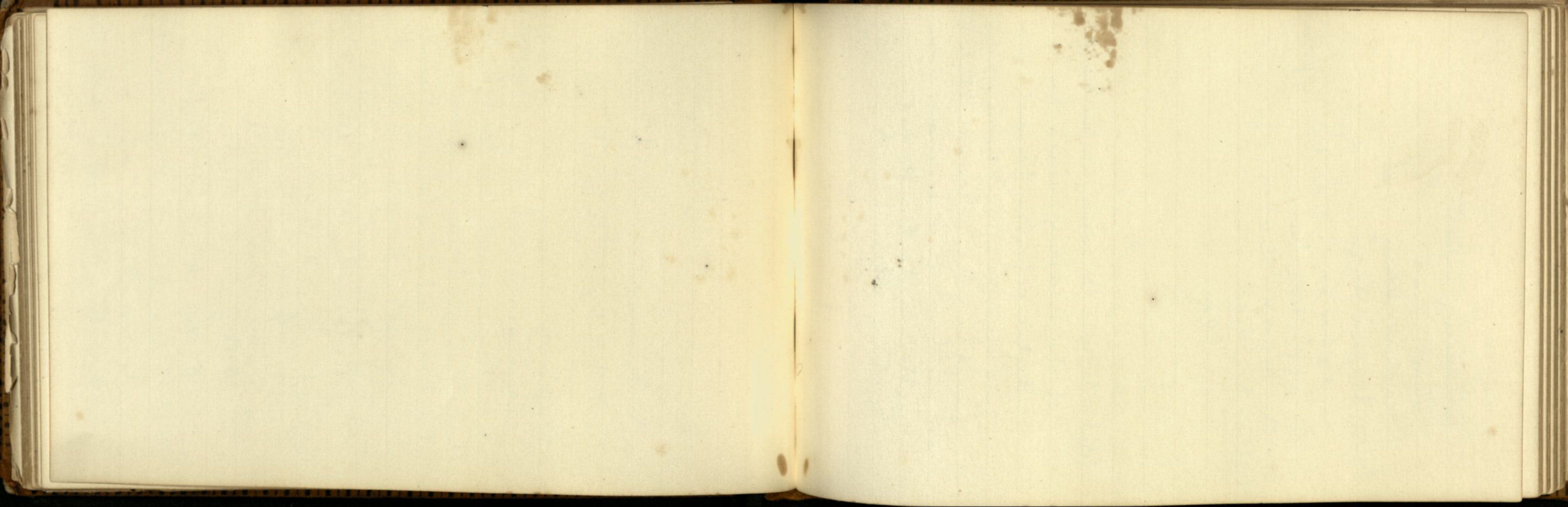

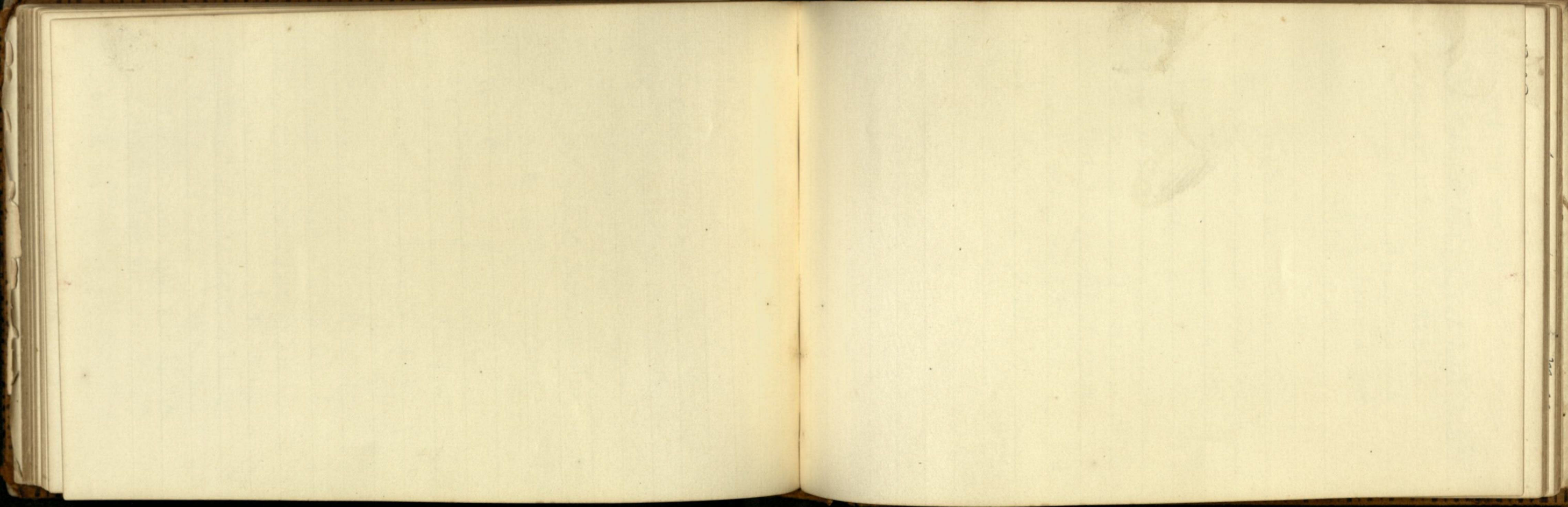
