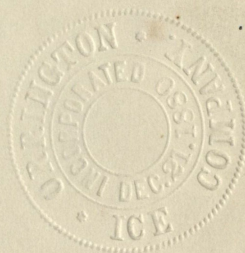
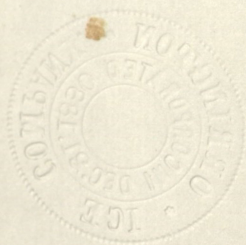

By-Laws

Article 1

Organization of the company

The style of said Association shall be the
Orangeton Ice Company

Said partners to each contribute twelve hundred

day of September next and the balance at
such time or times as the directors may order

All profits shall be equally divided and
all expenses of the business and all losses shall

Duties of Officers - President

Section 1 The President shall call and preside
at the annual meeting, he shall call meetings
at any other time upon the written application
of two or more members, he shall authenticate
all papers, he shall draw all warrants on the
Treasurer of said corporation

In absence of the President the company may
choose one of their number to preside

Secretary

It shall be the duty of the Secretary to record
the doings of all company meetings, post
notices of Company meetings when so
directed by the Directors of said company
make assessments upon shares when so directed
by the directors of said Company commit such
assessments to the Treasurers together with his

warrant for collection, and make a record of such assessments and the date of commitments for collection

Treasurer

It shall be the duty of the Treasurer, to receive all moneys belonging to the Company disburse the same only upon warrants drawn by the President collect assessments from the share holders when authorised so to do and submit to the board of directors annually for approval a detailed report of the financial condition of the company

He shall also report the financial condition of the Company at any other time if so requested by a vote of the Company. he shall give bonds for the faithful performance of his duties in such amount and with such securities as the board of Directors may require

Board of Directors

Correct Books of account shall be kept which shall always be open to the inspection of all parties or their legal representatives in which shall be regularly entered all monies received and paid and purchases sales transactions and accounts relating to the business of said firm

An account of stock shall be taken and the acct between said parties shall be settled as often as once in every year and oftener if requested in writing by either party

No money or other property shall be withdrawn by either party or applied to his own use except with the written consent of the others, and in every such case the same shall be charged and his share of the profits reduced in proportion to the amount withdrawn.

Neither of said parties shall become surety for any person or bind the firm for surety in any case without the written consent of the others.

Compensation

The President Secretary and Treasurer shall receive such compensation for their services as the Board of Directors shall decide and determine.
