in Ossington to sing and believing the exercises
of the evening to be profitable, agreed to meet again
on the sixteenth inst at which meeting, the fol-
lowing action was taken viz,

Voted That we resolve ourselves into an Association
for mutual improvement in Sacred and
Secular Music.

" That we choose a committee of three to
draft a constitution for this Association and
report at the next meeting

Orrington Dec, 21st 1892,

The Association met at the Corner School-house agreeably to adjournment.

Meeting called to order by Isaac L. Fowler.

Resolved To hear the report of the committee to draft a constitution. Said Committee reported as follows:

Your Committee having attended to the duties assigned them report the following

Constitution

Article 1st This Association shall be called the Orrington Musical Association.

" 2^d The Officers of this Association shall be a President, two Vice Presidents, Secretary, Treasurer, a Prudential Committee of three a Leader and two assistant Leaders all of whom shall be chosen annually by ballot or hand vote as the Association may decide at the time.

" 3^d It shall be the duty of the President and in his absence of the senior vice President to preside at all meetings of the Association and with the assistance of the other officers,

To maintain such Order as is necessary for the occasion.

Art. 4th The Secretary, Treasurer and Prudential Committee shall respectively perform the duties that belong to their several offices.

" 5th It shall be the duty of the Leader and his assistants to conduct all the musical exercises of the Association.

" 6th The President, Secretary and Prudential Committee shall constitute a Board of Directors to confer with the Leader and his assistants in providing business for, and deciding questions pertaining to the musical performances of the Association.

" 7th Expenses of this Association shall be met by contributions taken at the discretion of the Prudential Committee unless otherwise ordered at the annual meeting.

" 8th This Association shall hold its annual meeting for choice of officers at the

call of the directors on or after the first
monday of October. Notice to be given
from the Pulpit.

Art. 7th This Constitution can be altered or amended
by vote of two thirds of the members
present at any annual meeting.

" 10th Any person may become a member of
this Association by subscribing this
constitution.

The foregoing resolutions passed unanimously by a rising vote.

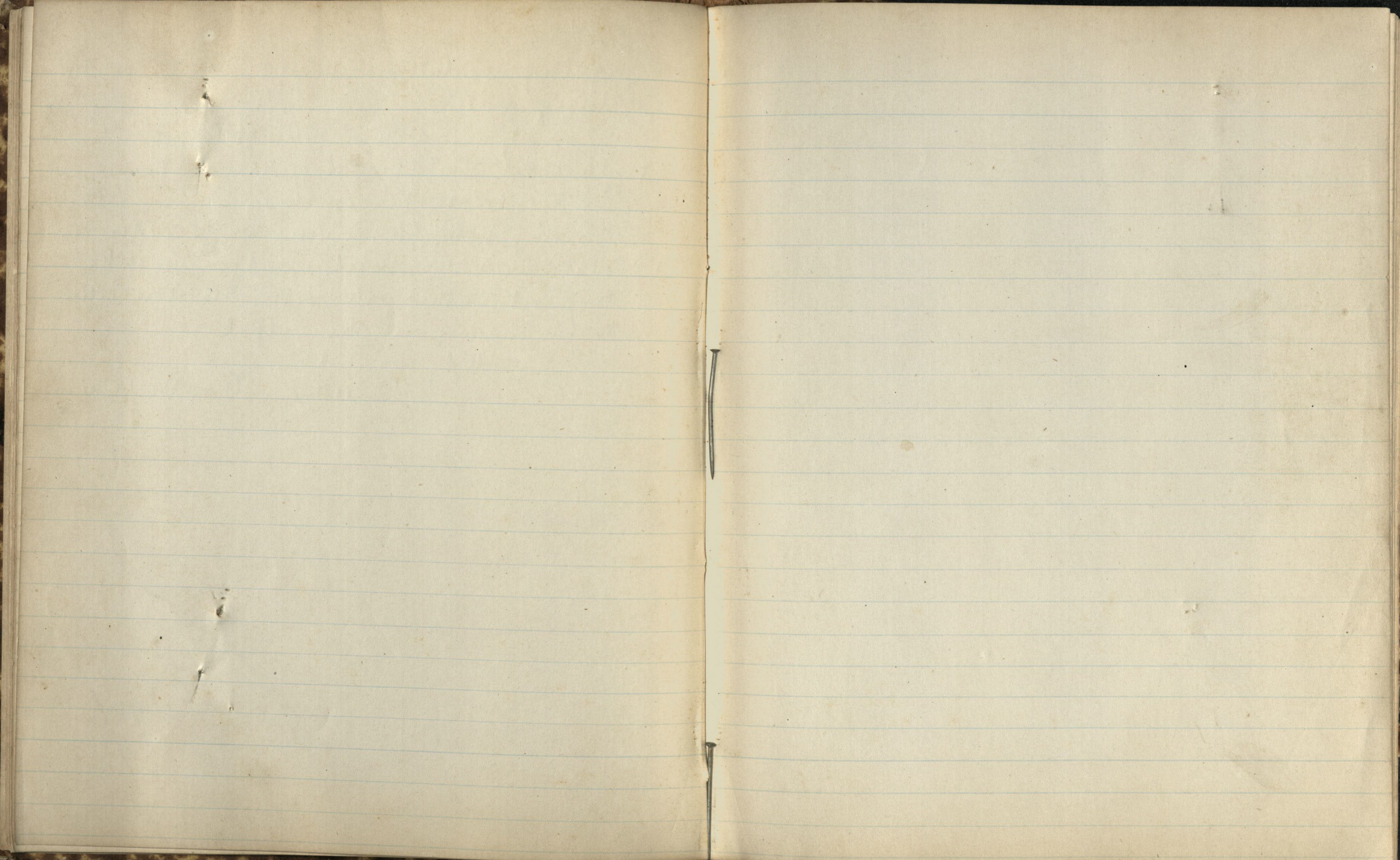
