Sir

The taxes on Mr Evans' land this year are - ~~in the whole~~ four Dollars & forty six cents, which are ~~chiefly~~ payable by 1st Sept. - The Collector says he shall enforce the collection of all taxes as soon as they are payable, & if you send me the money by that time I will see them discharged - To make even charge, I charge ~~but~~ fifty four cents for seeing to the business this year, so that you may conveniently send it for the whole in a five Dollar bill -
