Mr Greenleaf Esq
Sir yours of the 5 of Feby
last was recd Mr Dueris said he would write
you when I see him in June but I expect
he thought it not an object for him to
trade was the reason he did not write, but
he would be very glad to sell at some
price I am not able to say what he
would sell for but I think if he could
obtain what we have paid out for
taxes within six years it would be
better to sell than to continue to pay
such taxes much longer if you can get
any offer for it you will inform me
I expect to see Mr Dueris in May & will
consult with him about selling, should
be glad if you would inform me the
amount of taxes the last year & whether
you have recd the money from Hill &
Starratt as the money was deposited then
for the purpose of paying the taxes before
I wrote you
