Mr Greenleaf Esq Dear Sir yours of the 27 July  
& this day recd I will state that I was at  
Salem N.H. & saw Mr. Swins & stated to him  
what Messrs Hill & Storrell wrote me by your  
request a bout the price of the Land & Mr Swins  
gave me a Deed that <sup>if</sup> the Land could be sold  
I could Deed to the purchaser & I now wish you  
would close the sale if you can but I hope  
you will be able to obtain one dollar per  
Acre or at least ~~something~~ between 75 cent & \$1.00  
but you had better close the <sup>sale</sup> as you see if  
you cant do any better, but I should be  
glad if you could alter the payment so as  
to have one fourth down the remainder in  
Three Equal payments there is 128 Acres of  
Land in the hole I expect to be at Bangor  
in September next & should you close the  
sale & write me before that time I will  
make the deed & leave it with Messrs Hill  
& Storrell or if you should have business at  
Bangor & would visit me then in September  
& write me what day you would be  
there I will visit you at the time unless  
sickness or something more than I know of takes  
place to prevent - please to write me as soon  
as you can for I think I shall want to go to  
Bangor the first of next month - you will  
make the purchaser pay the taxes for this year  
if you can yours Respectfully  
William Carlton
