but a few days since as I was absent to
Boston but I now inclose you the five
Dollars for the Taxes this year together with
your fees, I wish you would make a
savin in the Highway Taxes if you can
possible you might get the Highway Taxes
worked out for a les sum then what the
Taxes are we presume you will due
the best you can with it I wish
you would be good enough to inform
me of the Taxes yearly that I can
discharge them without cost should I
be able to due so, I consider your
attention to this business as a great
favor so far
