Mass Greenleaf Esq

Sir yours of the 10 May I duly
recd but as I had know orders from Mr. Owens to
pay I waited to write him I now inclose five
Dollars which ^{will} pay monthly for the Highway Tax
& the remainder will be paid soon by sending
it in a Letter unless Mr. Owens should send
to Williamsburg with a Bill to sell I would
just enquire if the Highway Taxes could not
be worked out for something less than the amount
of Taxes if so I wish you would get it done
as low as you can & you will oblige
