

I Enos Kunnels of Buxford in the
 County of Essex and Commonwealth of
 Massachusetts aged seventy seven years testi-
 fy and say; that I was a soldier of the
 Revolutionary army, and served three
 years therein from 14th of Feb 1777;
 that at the time of enlisting for said term
 I was, and have ever since been an in-
 habitant of said Buxford; that I served
 as aforesaid in the 7th Massachusetts
 Regiment, that said Regiment was comman-
 ded by Col Ichabod Alden, that William
 Stacy was Lt Colonel thereof, that
 said Alden was killed and said Stacy
 taken prisoner by the Indians at Cherry
 Valley on the 11th Nov 1778, that Daniel
 Whiting was Major of said Regiment &
 took the command after the said 11th of Nov-
 ember, that said Whiting was afterwards
 promoted to Lt Colonel and transferred
 to another Regiment, and that for a short
 time before my discharge Lt Col John Brooks
 commanded said 7th Regiment and gave me
 my said discharge. Enos Kunnels
