the expiration of said term when I was honorably dischar-
ged at Peekskill in the State of New York; but my discharge
has long since been lost — I further declare that I am a
pensioner of the United States holdin Certificate No

of Greenbills in the State of New York to be my true &
lawful Attorney for me & in my name to apply to the
Land Agent of this State & to receive for me the grant
Made by the General Court to Soldiers who performed

necessary for the final settlement of my said claim
