BOSTON, February 24th 1809

THIS CERTIFIES, That *Abiel Turner*, of *Turner*
in the County of *Oxford*, (formerly of *2 Massachusetts*
Regiment.)

a Soldier in the late American Army who was returned as a part of
this State's quota of said Army, enlisted for during the war with
Great-Britain, served three years after having so enlisted, and was
honorably discharged, hath drawn Lot No. *One* in a Town-
ship of Land, called *Mars'-Hill*, located and lotted, in the eastern
part of this Commonwealth, agreeably to a Resolve of the General
Court, passed March 9, 1804, and that the said Lot contains two hun-
dred acres, bounded

North on lot N^o 2 East on
the Eastern line of the State, South on land
of the State, West on lot N^o 3.

according to a plan of the survey of said township, called *Mars'*
Hill, taken by CHARLES TURNER, jun. Esq. September, 1804, and
lodged in the Secretary's office ;—and that on return of this *Certifi-*
cate into the said Secretary's office, with satisfactory evidence that
the duties required by a Resolve of the fifth of March, 1801, have
been performed, within four years from the ninth of March, 1804,
the said *Abiel Turner*
shall be entitled to a deed of the said Lot of Land in fee simple, to
be given by the Secretary in behalf of the Commonwealth.
